Businesses have a responsibility to ensure employee travel is safe and secure.

CONSIDER POLICIES OR PROCEDURES WITHIN THE BUSINESS THAT ALLOW FOR:

- 1. Remote or home based work before and after a trip
- 2. Comp day for travel on weekends/holidays
- 3. Convenient departure and arrival times (i.e. arrive day before/stay a night after)
- 4. A reduction or elimination of last minute trips (burden to family commitments)
- 5. Concierge services
- 6. Reimbursement for Global Entry and/or TSA Pre-Check status
- 7. Help with booking travel & filing expenses
- 8. Seat upgrades
- 9. Opportunity for direct flights
- 10. Adjusted workload if always catching up before leaving or after arriving
